A bed time story allows children		Though many children in KS2 are 'free readers' it is important that listening to them read aloud occurs during the week. As in KS1, having stories read aloud to them should continue as this helps to further develop tone, intonation and expression as the text becomes more complex. Exposure of and discussion around word meaning, inferred messages and news and magazine articles is beneficial.

Handwriting exercises e.g. fine motor skill activities, letter formation or handwriting packs. Reading comprehension tasks. A research project around a particular topic in order to support children's writing in class. Packs of work to aid revision at specific times of year.
